

**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER
OF THE TOWN OF LONA CONING**

RESOLUTION 2025-01

WHEREAS, the Town of Lonaconing has defined a meeting attendance requirement of the elected Council; and

WHEREAS, said requirement has not been formalized in the Town Charter.

WHEREAS, during the course of preparing the Amendment to the Charter, other additional changes required.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** this 7th day of April, 2025
by the Mayor and Council of Lonaconing, Maryland, that the following amendments to the Charter
for the Town of Lonaconing is hereby adopted:

1. Section 370A – Attendance

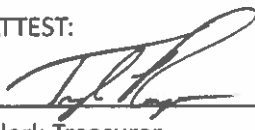
Elected Council members shall not be absent for more than two regularly scheduled meetings as defined in Section 370 of the Charter in a term year from June to May. Special meetings shall not be included in Council member attendance record. Council members may request an excused absence by vote of other Council members for a meeting in which they did not attend. After two unexcused absences, said Council member will be removed from Council and vacancy shall be filled in accordance with Section 375 of the Charter.

2. Section 370 – Meetings

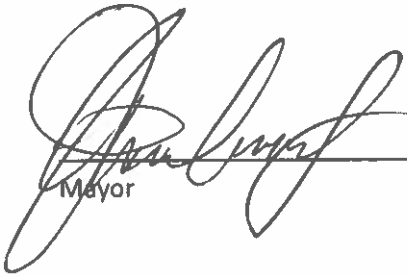
The newly elected Council shall meet at [8:00 p.m.] **6:00 p.m.** on the first Monday of June following its election for the purpose of organization, after which the Council shall meet regularly at such times as may be prescribed by its rules but not less frequently than once each month. Special meetings shall be called by the Clerk/Treasurer upon the request of the Mayor or a majority of the members of the Council. All meetings of the Council shall be open to the public, and the rules of the Council shall provide that residents of the town shall have a reasonable opportunity to be heard at any meeting in regard to any municipal question. It is further **RESOLVED** that the effective date of this Resolution shall be June 2, 2025.
